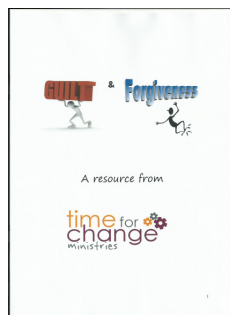

Guilt and Forgiveness course

The TFC Guilt and Forgiveness course has been run in a jail in the Philippines, and works just as well in another culture and language as it does in its home country of Wales!



The 8 session course is interactive and caters for people of all abilities. It is a good evangelistic tool, giving a clear gospel presentation as it helps prisoners face and start to deal with their guilt and consider forgiveness.

Book review



I recently read Rico Tice's new book, **Honest Evangelism**. He explains what evangelism is, the reasons we find it difficult, whose job it is and what an evangelist is (you might be surprised in chapter 6).

Rico reminds us that there is hostility to the gospel but there is also hunger for the gospel. He reminds us that in order to share the good news that Jesus has died for our sins, we need to share the bad news that our sin makes God angry and someone has to die for it.

He explains what we need to say to share the good news. I'm not going to give all the answers away, suffice to say, if you've run the Christianity Explored course, it will ring some bells. Ask them questions, chat your faith, pray for God to work in this person's heart, invest in the relationship.


Read the book. It's short, it's punchy, it's to the point. It's honest about evangelism.
